911	Police, fire or medical emergency line. For when immediate action is required: a life or property is in danger, an overdose is occurring, a crime is in progress, or you have a medical emergency

306.382.6935	Fire Community Support Workers. Call between 8:00 am- 12:15 am for instances involving substance use and public intoxication <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Minor disturbances • Suspicious persons and loitering • 3rd party mediation and conflict resolution • Deterring negative street activity • Providing directions and business information • Needle pick-up • People exhibiting mental illness behaviours

306.975.2476	Contact the City's Customer Care Centre to request cleanup of garbage, human biohazards (e.g., feces, vomit, or blood), or to report an encampment.
306.933.6200	Saskatoon Crisis and Intervention Services. For calling 24/7 about mental health and addictions crisis support. Ask for PACT police team to come
